**ENTRY ORDERING DISINTERMENT
[R.C. 517.24]**

Upon application and for good cause shown, the Court finds that notice of a hearing in this matter has either been given or waived by all proper parties in interest and that any and all consents to the disinterment have been filed.

The Court further finds the allegations made in the Application are true, and that no testimony or other evidence has been presented to establish that disinterment is against the decedent's religious beliefs.

- The Court further finds that a permit has been issued pursuant to R.C. 517.23(B) by the Board of Health (or other authorized agency) and that it has been filed herein.

This Court therefore orders the disinterment of the deceased from _____ Cemetery located in Wood County, Ohio, and the remains of the deceased shall be re-interred at _____ Cemetery located in _____ County, State of _____, as described in the Application. The Board of Trustees, the Trustees or Board of the Cemetery Association, or other officers having control or management of the Cemetery, or the officer of a municipal corporation who has control or management of a municipal Cemetery shall have at least 30 days from the receipt of this order to perform the disinterment.
